Students will complete and submit their assignments by 11:59 p.m. each evening. Students should expect to have assignments to submit in every course, every weekday. I will send all school-wide announcements to students via email and Canvas as well. Teachers will be available during regular school hours via email to communicate with students, provide feedback, and answer questions.
