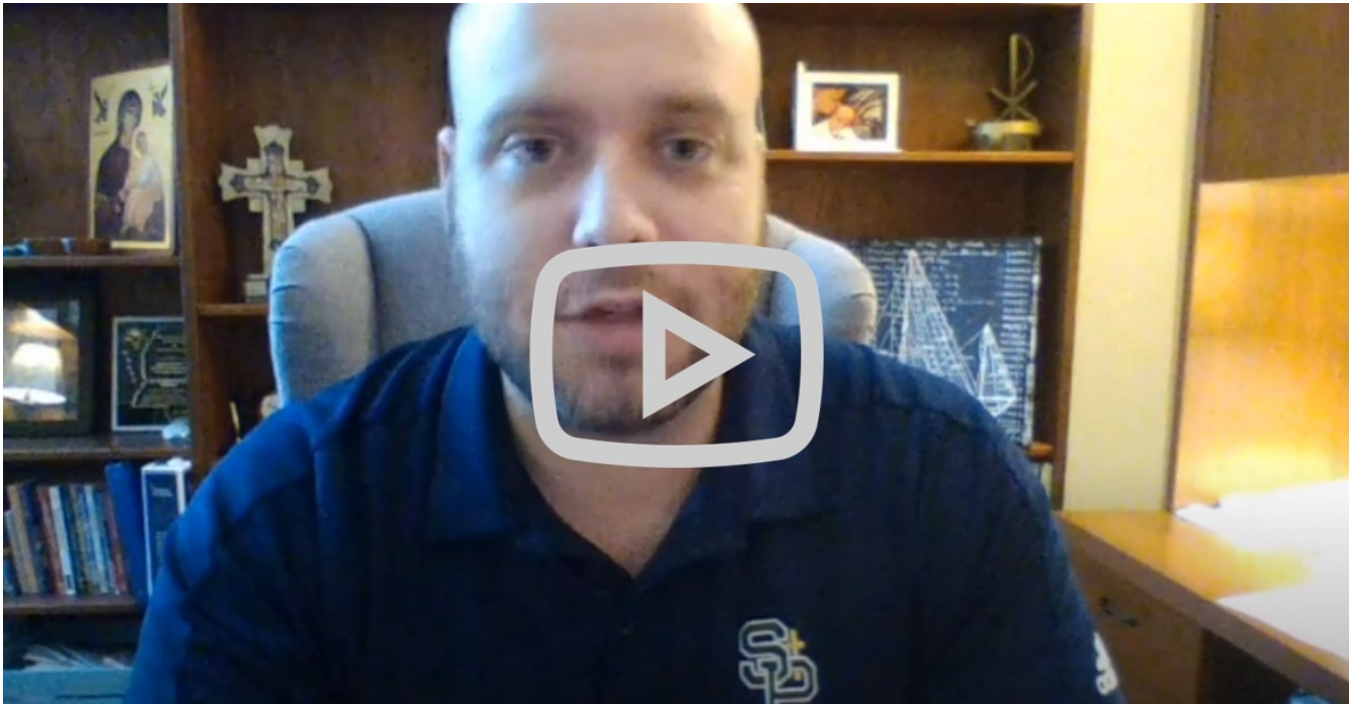

Dear St. Patrick Students, Parents, and Families:

We are excited and ready to begin the 2020-21 school year tomorrow morning. Our administration, faculty, and staff have worked hard to prepare for the first day of school. We cannot wait to see the Fighting Irish!

Thank you in advance for your patience as we navigate these uncharted waters and unprecedented times. We have planned for nearly every possible scenario, and we are prepared to make adjustments as needed. Thank you for your support and cooperation.

Just a few reminders for tomorrow morning...

- Class begins at 8:15 a.m. Students will report to their first period class upon arriving on campus. We will have staff members assist students with getting to first period if they

forget their schedule.

- Face masks and social distancing are required.
- Students who are registered to ride the bus should arrive at their bus location a few minutes early.
- All students will have their temperature checked either prior to boarding the bus or prior to entering the campus. Students with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be allowed to stay.
- Students must stay home for any one of the following criteria:
  - Positive test for COVID-19.
  - Individual or any member of the household experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 whether they have a positive test or not.
  - Known close contact (within the last 14 days) with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19. Close contact is defined as within 6 feet for a period of over 15 minutes.
