As a reminder, students must stay home from school for any one of the following criteria:

- Positive test for COVID-19.
- Individual or any member of the household experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 whether they have a positive test or not.
- Known close contact (within the last 14 days) with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19. Close contact is defined as within 6 feet for a period of over 15 minutes.

While at home, students may participate in our School-to-Home Virtual Learning program and attend all classes virtually. Please give us a call for more information.
